(Hong Kong, 20 June 2011) Cable car service at Ngong Ping 360 will resume at 10:00am tomorrow (Tuesday, 21 June) as planned, following the completion of scheduled maintenance works on the ropeways.

With the reopening of Ngong Ping 360, visitors will have the opportunity to experience the excitement of the Shaolin Kung Fu Showcase together with a wide array of special promotions, just in time for the summer holidays in July and August.

**Ngong Ping Shaolin Kung Fu Showcase**

From 1 July to 31 August 2011, the Shaolin Kung Fu Showcase will feature startling demonstrations of modern and traditional kung fu by some 20 Shaolin masters from the Mainland, that will thrill guests with awe-inspiring displays of martial arts and daring stunts.

"The unique outdoor setting of Ngong Ping Village with its authentic Chinese structures and proximity to the Big Buddha makes Ngong Ping 360 an ideal location for the Shaolin Kung Fu Showcase. Visitors will be overwhelmed by the daring stunts made popular in Shaolin-inspired action movies," added Mr Li.

Highlights of the programme will include the debut of *Qixingquan* (Seven Star Fist 七星拳) which was featured in the famous movie "Shaolin", it is an exercise characterised by swift, concise movements inspired by the seven stars of the Big Dipper; performance on staggered piling (梅花樁); and an "handstand hoist" (倒掛金鉤) at the tourist attraction. The Premiere cum Kick-off Ceremony for the Shaolin Kung Fu Showcase will be held at Ngong Ping Village on 29 June. Guests will have the opportunity to preview authentic Shaolin kung fu from the great Shaolin masters on that day.

Another impressive spectacle during the two-month performance period will be a series of free daily workshops. Hosted by the Shaolin masters, these interactive workshops will give visitors the opportunity to practice *Qixingquan* and immerse themselves in Shaolin kung fu.

For photography enthusiasts, the programme will offer special photo-taking sessions capturing all the excitement of this traditional Chinese martial arts.
