Ngong Ping Cable Car: Fact Sheet

Terminal Locations	<p>Tung Chung Cable Car Terminal: a short walk from MTR's Tung Chung Station.</p> <p>Ngong Ping Cable Car Terminal: on Ngong Ping Plateau, Lantau Island, within a 5-minute walk from the Tian Tan Buddha.</p>
The Experience	<p>Between Ngong Ping 360's Tung Chung and Ngong Ping Cable Car Terminals.</p> <p>There are two angle stations, located at Airport Island and Nei Lak Shan. Cable cars do not stop at these stations.</p>
Distance	<p>5.7km (3.5 miles) gondola cableway, supported by 8 towers.</p> <p>Ngong Ping Cable Car is the biggest cableway in Asia, and one of the most impressive ever constructed.</p>
Experience Time	<p>Approximately 25 minutes.</p>
Number of Cabins	<p>109 cabins</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Standard Cabins Each cabin can carry up to 17 passengers, 10 seated and 7 standing.- Crystal Cabins Each cabin can carry up to 10 passengers.- 360 Sky Lounge Each cabin can carry up to 8 passengers.
Cableway System	<p>A continuous circulating bi-cable aerial ropeway, selected for its superior ride quality and high standards of safety and reliability. This is the first of its kind to be installed in Hong Kong.</p>
The View	<p>Spectacular 360 degree panoramic views of North Lantau Country Park, the South China Sea, Tung Chung Bay and the Hong Kong International Airport.</p> <p>The mountainous terrain of the North Lantau Country Park boasts a rich variety of flora (over 100 species) and diverse array of birds and butterflies.</p>
