Ngong Ping Village Dining, Shopping, Attractions & Entertainment

Ngong Ping Village is located adjacent to Ngong Ping Cable Car Terminal, just minutes from the Tian Tan Buddha Statue on Hong Kong's Lantau Island.

Set on a 1.5 hectare site, the Village has been carefully constructed to reflect and maintain the cultural and spiritual integrity of the Ngong Ping area.

Architecturally designed to incorporate traditional Chinese design features, the Village also boasts beautifully landscaped gardens, creating a relaxing and natural ambience for guests to enjoy their peaceful surroundings and the plethora of dining, retail and entertainment experiences on offer.

DINING

Sumptuous banquets or a simple snack, local fare or international cuisine, Ngong Ping Village's dining options are countless.

Ngong Ping Garden Restaurant specialises in Guangdong and Chiu Chow delicacy, an ideal choice for guests craving authentic Chinese food. This spacious 8,500 sq. feet traditional Chinese themed restaurant is operated by Pak Loh. It has a maximum capacity for 380 guests over two levels. Three private rooms are available: two can hold 34 people, and the third has a capacity for 15 guests, providing a perfect choice for meetings and conventions.

Renowned in Hong Kong for its delicious food and loyal diners, Pak Loh has over 40 years experience in restaurant business. Ngong Ping Garden Restaurant has its own barbecue facility offering freshly roasted pork and suckling pigs, while at the same time it also serves special vegetarian dishes for guests.

Euro Go Go offers an array of delicious modern European food including honey chicken wings, potato platters, garlic mussels and escargot, to name just a few.

For the sweet tooth, **da dolce** has an impressive selection of traditional Italian gelato, with all natural ingredients and no artificial colourings. Meanwhile coffee lovers will delight in the aroma of freshly brewed coffee at **Starbucks Coffee**, which also serves other western snacks and beverages.

Japanese and Taiwanese snacks and noodles are available at **Zen Noodle Café** and **Zen Taiwanese Bistro**, while one of Hong Kong's most popular dessert eateries, **Honeymoon Dessert**, offers a range of delicious dishes, including mango pancake and sago sweet soup.

RETAIL

Ngong Ping Village is home to a diverse range of themed retail outlets, stocking an exciting selection of souvenir items, gifts, memorabilia and packaged Asian delicacies.

At **Souvenirs To Go**, guests can choose from a cultural fusion of themed gifts from North America, Hong Kong and Mainland China, including Chinese knots, embroidery, ceramics and brassware.

Giff Station is a one-stop-solution for elaborately ornate jade, pearl and crystals.

A set of chopsticks is the quintessential souvenir item for international visitors, and **Chopsticks Gallery** has a great selection to choose from. Different styles available include: Korean, Japanese, Chinese and Vietnamese.

The **China Art Window** caters to visitors wanting to collect a piece of traditional Chinese history and culture. Specialising in antique and contemporary pots, plates, jades and statuettes of Buddha, authentic artifacts and replicas are available for all budgets.

For unique souvenirs, **Red Plus** offers guests exquisite embroidery handicrafts, whereas **Wooden House** is a place for superb wood carvings. **Peking Opera** offers the "Quintessence of China" products, including Chinese opera accessories and opera mask, bringing travelers a unique artistic charm and Chinese traditions.

R & B Souvenirs Shop provides over 100 flashy patterns with blings imported from Korea. Your favorite patterns will be imprinted on different apparels at once!

Meanwhile, **Woo Kee Loong (Kwai Yue) Cake Shop** specialises in Chiu Chow delicacies such as freshly-baked, crunchy, peanut-centred *ap keng tong* or 'duck neck sweets', dinosaur-shaped dumplings and lobster sugar. **Happy Smart Delicacy** offers local specialties from Tai O, such as fish maw, shrimp paste and salty fish, which are perfect to buy as gifts or take home.

Ngong Ping Village is also home to two exciting attractions: **Walking with Buddha** and **Monkey's Tale Theatre**. Bookings are recommended of these attractions, which are open seven days a week.

BIG BUDDHA

A day at Ngong Ping 360 would not be complete without a visit to the nearby Tian Tan Buddha statue and Po Lin Monastery.

The Tian Tan Buddha is the world's largest, seated, outdoor, bronze Big Buddha statue. Constructed from 202 bronze pieces, the statue weighs over 250 tonnes and soars 34 metres into the air.

Sitting atop 268 steps, the Tian Tan Buddha is positioned on a lotus throne, overlooking Ngong Ping Village and the Ngong Ping Plateau.

It is a convenient, five-minute walk from Ngong Ping Village.

WISDOM PATH

Wisdom Path features an arrangement of 38 giant wood columns measuring 8-10 metres long and 1 metre wide to showcase calligraphy by master of Chinese studies Professor Jao Tsung-I. These wood columns are arranged in a "∞" pattern.

Heart Sutra, full name Sāhasrikā-prajñā-pāramitā Heart Sutra, is a famous Buddhist classic.
