(Hong Kong, 23 June 2026) Ngong Ping 360's 20th anniversary celebration brings non-stop excitement from day to night! This year marks the debut of the Cable Car Night Ride, alongside the first-ever full themed makeover of all 108 cable cars. Among them, 24 cable cars are created in collaboration with renowned local and international brands, forming 24 one-of-a-kind themed cable cars, while the remaining 80+ cable cars are adorned with a neon light theme. At night, all cable cars will transform into "night-ride cable cars", revealing luminous designs under UV light and creating an immersive visual experience for guests.

Ngong Ping Village also offers a host of surprises. A retired cable car makes its first “landing” as a 20th anniversary-themed photo spot, while various Hong Kong-style scenes such as mahjong and bing sutt are featured throughout the Village. Guests can also collect stamps around the village, with selected stamps using special ink to create a collectable fluorescent postcard.

As night falls, the Ngong Ping Village will transform into a nostalgic neon light main street, complemented by live performances produced by Commercial Radio Hong Kong and featuring popular local singers. Amid dazzling lights and music, guests can experience distinctly different atmospheres from day to night.

The Cable Car Night Ride is available on eight designated weekends during the summer holiday period, with tickets now on sale at HK\$200 for adults and HK\$100 for seniors and children. Guests who wish to enjoy the experience from day to night can purchase a regular cable car ticket and add on the Night Ride experience for only HK\$100 for adults and HK\$50 for seniors and children, making it a full day of uninterrupted fun!

All 108 Cable Cars Debut with New Themed Designs for the First Time Transforming into “Night-ride Cable Cars”



For the first time in its history, Ngong Ping 360 has wrapped its entire fleet of 108 cable car cabins in themed designs. Among them, 24 cabins feature collaborations with 24 renowned local and international brands. Each cabin is infused with unique brand elements to create one-of-a-kind themed experiences. The remaining 80-plus

On eight designated evenings — 24, 25 July and 1, 2, 8, 9, 15, 16 August — Ngong Ping Cable Car will offer a night ride experience. Cable car operations will be extended until 10pm, with the last boarding at 9:30pm. As night falls, guests can take the cable car to overlook the night-time scenery of Lantau Island, the glittering lights of Hong Kong International Airport, the stunning views of the Hong Kong–Zhuhai–Macao Bridge, and the illuminated Big Buddha, immersing themselves in a tranquillity and romance.

At night, all cable cars will transform into “night-ride cable cars”! Guests who purchase night ride tickets will receive a mini UV flashlight. Let’s unlock surprise fluorescent patterns in different corners by turning on the flashlight inside the cabin!

Retired Cable Car “Landed” as a Photo Spot Create Your Own Postcard at Hong Kong-style Scenes



Neon Light Cable Car-themed Installation is on display at the Stupa Square in the Ngong Ping Village. For the first time, a Standard Cabin that once ran on the cable line has been brought down after retirement, becoming a distinctive photo spot. The cable car is accompanied by colorful neon signs, recreating Hong Kong's iconic neon street scenery. Guests can step inside the cabin and move through the vibrant lights to capture photos full of local charm and preserve unique memories of Ngong Ping 360's 20th anniversary.



The Ngong Ping Village presents three **Hong Kong Nostalgia Photo Spots**, allowing guests to relive cherished collective memories!

The “Mahjong” themed spot recreates the lively scene of a traditional Hong Kong mahjong play, complete with the clinking of tiles and echoes of winning declarations, creating a fun and bustling atmosphere. The “MTR Station” theme spot incorporates classic station sign designs and is paired with genuine MTR cabin seats, taking guests through familiar everyday journeys. The “Ngong Ping Bing Sutt” themed spot restores old Hong Kong's culinary charm with vintage booth seating and checker floor tiles.

As a major tourist attraction on Lantau Island in Hong Kong, Ngong Ping 360 offers a unique and exciting natural and cultural experience. The 5.7km Ngong Ping 360 Cable Car connects Tung Chung and Ngong Ping and is the longest bi-cable gondola system in Asia. It provides a visually spectacular 25-minute journey with panoramic views of North Lantau Country Park, the South China Sea, the Tian Tan Buddha (Big Buddha) statue, the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macau









Bridge, and Hong Kong International Airport, showcasing diverse flora and fauna.







Ngong Ping 360 introduced the Crystal+ Cabin in 2022, developed in France and Italy. Featuring fully transparent glass on the cabin floor and all four sides, it offers over 80% more panoramic views, allowing guests to enjoy a 360-degree, unobstructed view of Lantau Island and delivering a brand-new sightseeing experience.
